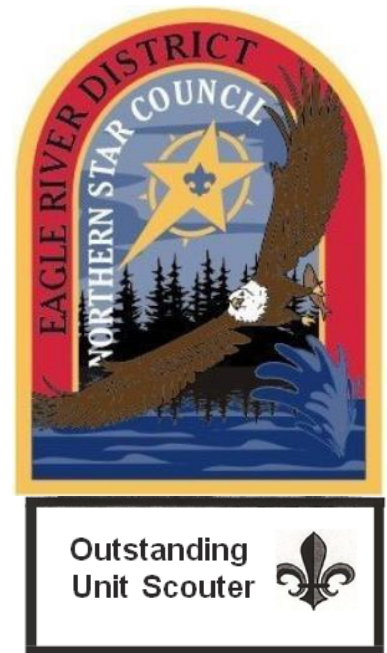


Eagle River District Outstanding Unit Scouter Award

Eagle River District Outstanding Unit Scouter Award

The *Eagle River Outstanding Unit Scouter Award* is . . .

- Presented annually by the District Committee
- For unit-level Scouters who give service to youth through unit activities
- Selected by the unit committee
- Approved by the unit commissioner.

Selection Criteria:

1. The recipient has been a registered member of the unit in any position for at least 2 years prior to the award presentation date.
2. The recipient has not been recognized with an *Outstanding Unit Scouter Award* in the previous 3 years.
3. The recipient's service should have had a significant impact on the ability to provide the Scouting program to youth within the unit.
4. The service should have been rendered over a sustained period, not just for a single event or activity.
5. The service need not have been in support of a District-level activity such as Camporee or Scout Expo. (The District Award of Merit recognizes that service.)
6. In the event that a Unit Commissioner has provided significant, sustained service directly to an individual unit, above and beyond that normally expected of a Commissioner, the unit committee might make an *Outstanding Unit Scouter Award* recommendation via their Assistant District Commissioner. This will be the one award for the unit.
7. While each unit may receive one *Outstanding Unit Scouter Award* per year, there is no obligation to submit a selection if there are no qualified candidates.

Additional notes:

Each chartered unit (pack, troop and crew) in the district may receive one Eagle River *Outstanding Unit Scouter Award* per year.

The Eagle River District *Outstanding Unit Scouter Award* does not replace the District Award of Merit, nor is the *Outstanding Unit Scouter Award* a requirement for the Award of Merit.
